RARE BLACK PUMA SPOTTED IN THE PYRENEES

The story goes that at the end of the war, prior to their return home, American servicemen released their regiment's puma mascots into the wild where they and their descendants have defied detection ever since. In the year 2000, another very different but equally impressive BLACK PUMA was released in(to) the region by vigneron, Luigi Bazzani.

Inspired by descriptions of the legendary beast as big, black, strong and sleek, Bazzani's BLACK PUMA Avoca Shiraz has lived up to its name and now, unleashed for the last 12 years on the public, it is sought out by winelovers around the world.
