- **Region:** Pyrenees. Victoria Australia
- **Varieties:** Cabernet Sauvignon 50%, Merlot 32%, Cabernet Franc 13% and Shiraz 5%
- **Winemaker:** Sean Schwager
- **Fermentation:** Open fermenters, plunged twice daily, basket pressed.
- **Maturation:** 36 months in French and American oak.
- **Alcohol:** 13.5% Vol

- **Tasting Notes:**
  - **Colour:** Vivid deep purple with ruby hues
  - **Nose:** Aromas of ripe blackcurrant, blueberry and blackberry with a hint of eucalypt and cedar oak barrel complexity.
  - **Palate:** This wine has been crafted from the exceptional 2008 vintage in the Pyrenees. The blend of four different varieties adds layers of texture and flavour. The wine exhibits ripe blackcurrant, blueberry and blackberry fruit flavours which persist through the palate giving great length. The wine is medium bodied with soft fine ripe tannins. The rich fruit flavours are complemented by cedar oak characters from the extended oak maturation. This complex, stylish and balanced wine is an outstanding example of Pyrenees “Cabernets” and is perfect for current drinking or cellaring for up to 8 years.
