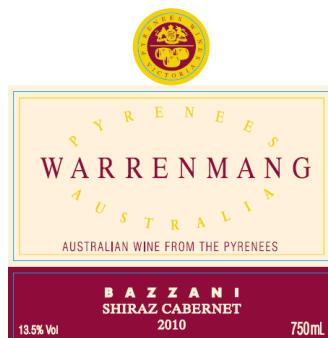

2010 BAZZANI SHIRAZ / CABERNET



- **Vintage:** 2010
- **Region:** Pyrenees. Victoria Australia
- **Varieties:** Shiraz 85% and Cabernet Sauvignon 15%
- **Winemaker:** Sean Schwager
- **Fermentation:** Open fermenters, plunged twice daily, basket pressed.
- **Maturation:** 30 months in French and American oak.
- **Alcohol:** 13.5% Vol
- **pH:** 3.51
- **TA:** TBA
- **Packaging:** 12 x 750ml
- **Cellar Door:** \$18.75
- **Tasting Notes:**
 - **Colour:** Deep purple with ruby hues
 - **Nose:** Aromas of ripe blackberry and blackcurrant fruits with a hint of spice and eucalypt overlaying cedar oak barrel complexity.
 - **Palate:** This generous wine has been crafted from another above average 2010 vintage in the Pyrenees. The blend of Shiraz and Cabernet Sauvignon grapes adds complexity to the aroma and flavour. The wine exhibits ripe blackberry and blackcurrant fruit flavours which persist through the palate giving great richness and length. The wine is full bodied with soft fine ripe tannins. The rich fruit flavours are complemented by cedar and savoury oak characters from the extended oak maturation. This complex and stylish wine is perfect for current drinking now or cellaring for up to 2+++years.
