- 84-86 ★★★ Fair to good. Wines with plenty of flavour (usually varietal) and good balance; free of technical faults.
- 80-83 ★★ Everyday wines: price is particularly relevant; under \$10 will represent good value.
- 75-79 ★ Also tasted: usually wines with some deficiency, technical or otherwise

The proposed merger of Warrenmang with other wine interests in 2004 failed to eventuate, through no fault of Luigi and Athalie Bazzani, who resumed full control of the business in February 2005, securing a number of large export orders to the US and Singapore. The Bazzanis emphasise it is business as usual, all thoughts of sale terminated.

- ★★★★★ **Black Puma Pyrenees Shiraz 2004** Dense, deep colour; extremely powerful dark fruits, the tannins interwoven, and the balance good, but leave it for 5 years. Cork.15° alc. **RATING** 94 **DRINK** 2020 \$80
- ★★★★★ **Estate Shiraz 2004** Spicy, earthy nuances to the bouquet and palate; medium-to full-bodied blackberry fruit, with good length, finish and aftertaste. Cork, 14.5° alc. **RATING** 93 **DRINK** 2016 \$60
- ★★★★★ **Bazzani Vinello 2004** bright purple-red; much more substance and structure than expected, the alcohol perfectly judged; red fruit and savoury notes are neatly counterpoised. Dolcetto/Nebbiolo/Barbera. Cork 13° alc. **RATING** 91 **DRINK** 2014 \$20
- ★★★★★ **Bazzani Shiraz Cabernet 2004** Red- purple; attractive savoury/spicy tannins run through the medium- bodied palate; good balance. Cork 13.5° alc. **RATING** 89 **DRINK** 2010 \$14
